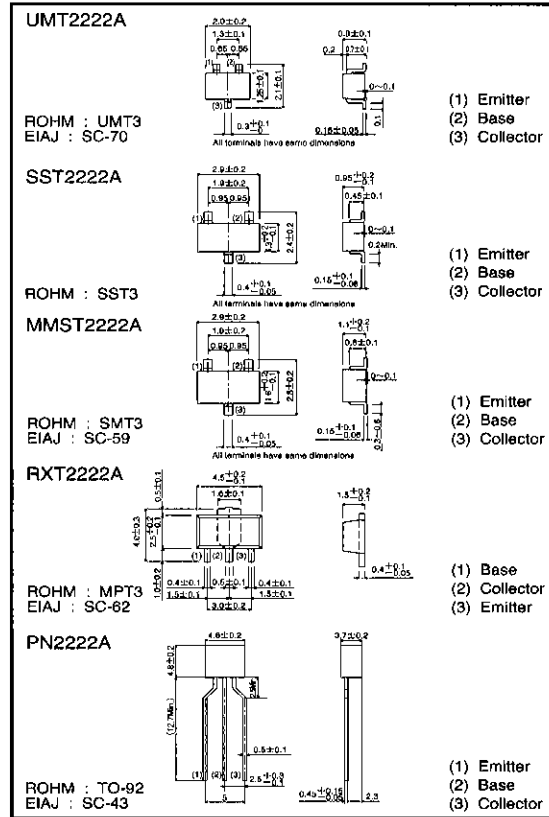

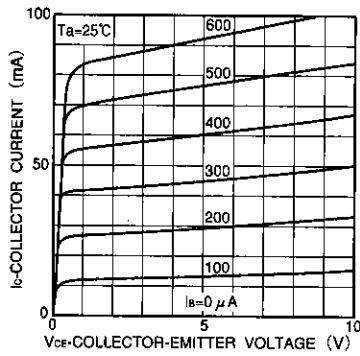


Fig.1 Grounded emitter output characteristics

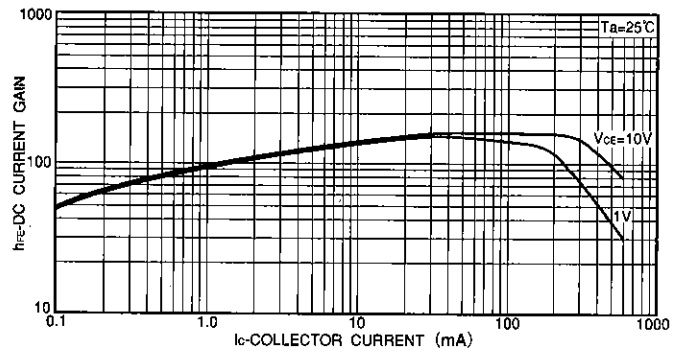


Fig.3 DC current gain vs. collector current ( I )

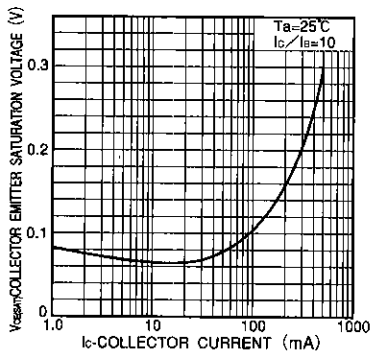


Fig.2 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current

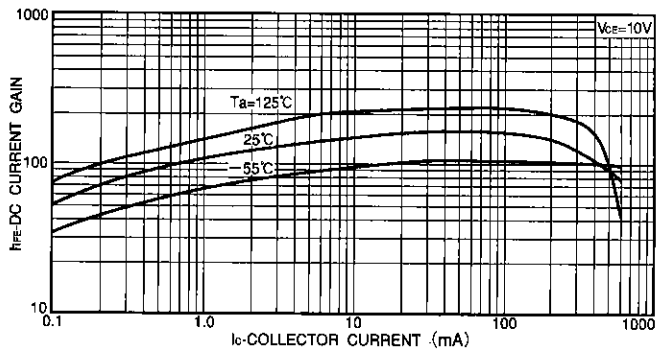


Fig.4 DC current gain vs. collector current ( II )

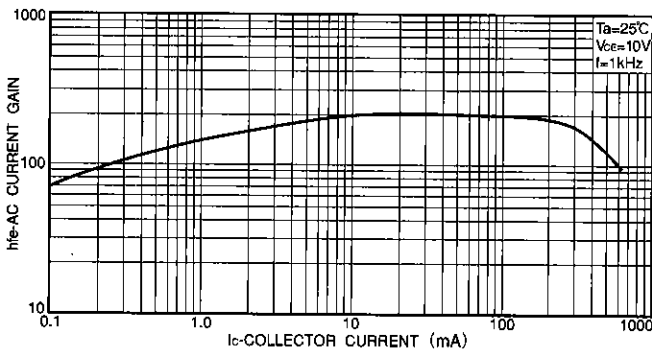


Fig.5 AC current gain vs. collector current

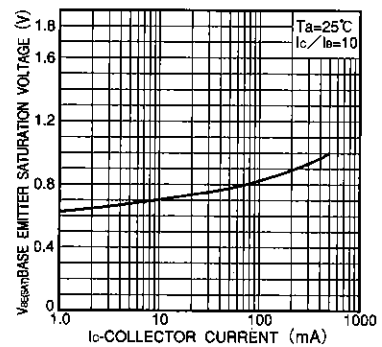


Fig.6 Base-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current

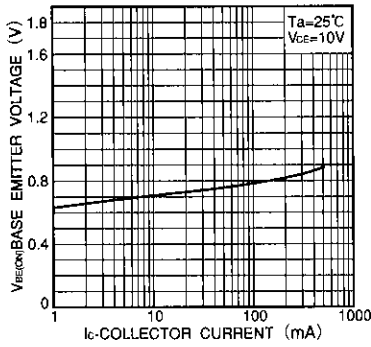


Fig.7 Grounded emitter propagation characteristics

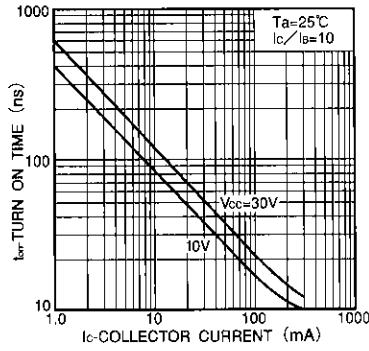


Fig.8 Turn-on time vs. collector current

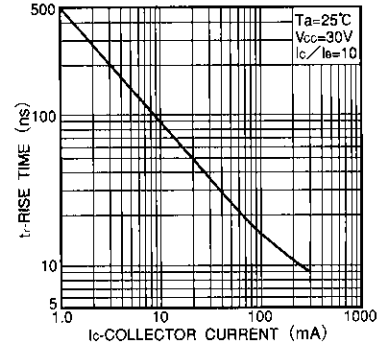


Fig.9 Rise time vs. collector current

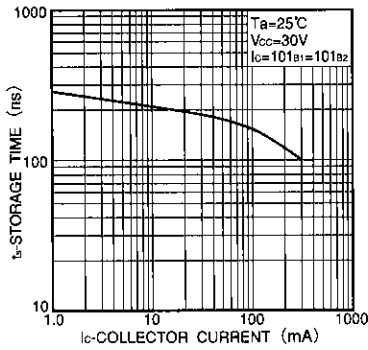


Fig.10 Storage time vs. collector current

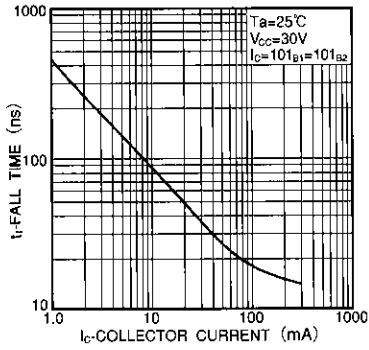


Fig.11 Fall time vs. collector current

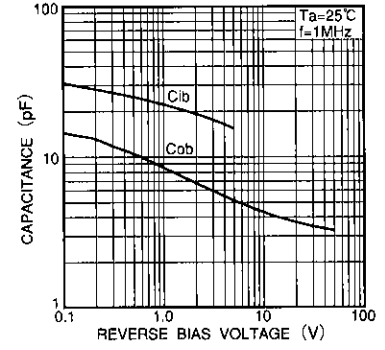


Fig.12 Input/output capacitance vs. voltage

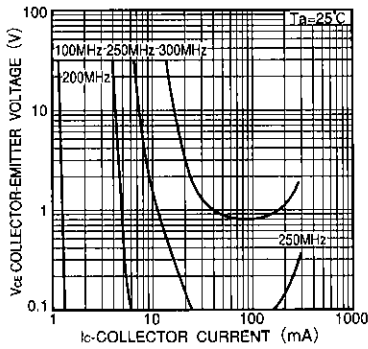


Fig.13 Gain bandwidth product

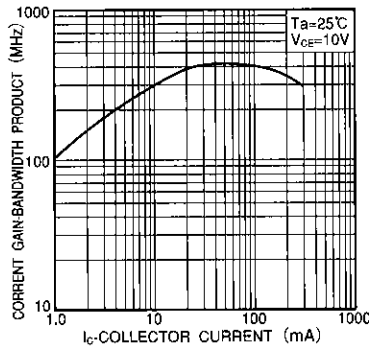


Fig.14 Gain bandwidth product vs. collector current

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
